- 1) Call to Order: Village President Heather Bender called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

- 9) DPW Report: DPW Jesse Bauer began with the topic of gravel for village roads; specifically Wells, 2nd, Russell and Cook Sts. Trustee Ryan Maldonis put up a figure of \$2000.00 and said to get done what can be done with that amount. Bauer said that the streets named above should be done first. President Heather Bender asked if there is enough gravel in stockpile to fill potholes. Trustee Scott Lull suggested having extra gravel in stockpile to fill holes at Bauer's discretion. Maldonis said enough gravel should be purchased to put one layer on all roads (10 loads?). Will discuss for next year's budget. Bauer was asked about the gutters for the hall. A number of options were brought up; obtaining quotes for a new one, contacting someone to possibly repair it, or buy a new one from Wal-Mart. The pressure washer has been repaired. End of report.

They want a sign placed on the end of what is now their driveway to prevent random traffic passing through. They said that people on ATVs and snowmobiles use the driveway as access to Bad Habits bar. The Carpenters said it is the village responsibility to place the sign(s). Discussion-Sewer Issues. Manholes and mains are old and need repair. Check into grant opportunities.
